The Council of Registered Builders of Nigeria (CORBON) established by the Builders Registration Act CAP No. 40 LFN to regulate the practice of Building profession in all its aspects and ramifications among other things, hereby inform the Public that it shall induct a batch of Builders.

Builders are the professionals licensed by CORBON as required by law to manage the construction of buildings in Nigeria. The training of Builders is structured to enable them acquire adequate knowledge and skills required at the strategic, tactical and operational levels of Building Production. Builders must carry out the Building Production Processes based on the provisions of Building Production Management standards to ensure the achievement of Project objectives.

- The standards are segmented as follows:
- Construction Programme
 - Project Quality Management Plan
 - Project Health and Safety Plan
 - Construction Methodology

The aforementioned provide assurances as follows:

- Adherence to production standards and specifications at the first attempt. New
- Protection of employees and the public from hazards that may arise due to production activities.
- Efficient management of production resources.
- Adherence to statutory requirements that may be necessary during production activities.
- Adherence to tests, inspections, quality certifications, etc. as may be required.

Therefore, Building Project Owners in Nigeria should engage Licensed Builders that must prepare and insist on approval of the following Builders' documents along with other contract documents prepared by other professionals that have inputs in Building Project delivery.

- Quality Management Plan
- Project Health & Safety Management Plan
- Construction Programme
- Construction Methodology
